

# Archidendron ramiflorum

Topaz Laceflower

Family Mimosaceae

Survival rating 2

**Form:** Shrub

**Height:** 3 - 5 m

**Flower Colour:** White

**Distribution:** Cooktown to Tully, in wet to very wet coastal and upland rainforest.

## Notes:

When growing in good conditions, the huge leaves of Archidendron ramiflorum provide a splendid show. The white flowers, which have extremely long stamens, can completely cover the trunk while the bright red fruit are the largest produced by any Archidendron.

It must be well protected from dry winds and watered regularly, and can be grown in full sun in very high rainfall areas.
